- Increasing demand for professionals who are trained to design, implement, and supervise behavior analytic programs for individuals with autism and related disorders, and for a variety of other students with and without disabilities.
- Opens the door to a variety of career opportunities, including opportunities in educational settings, hospitals, private and non-profit agencies, counseling practices, and residential treatment settings.
- There is room for entrepreneurship in the field and a number of Manhattanville alumni have started their own successful independent practices.

Look at the need!

• The Behavior Analyst Certification Board (BACB) reported in, "U.S. Employment Demand for Behavior Analysts" that between 2010 and 2018, the annual demand for Board Certified Behavior Analysts increased by approximately 1,950%. This is driven in large part by the increasing rates of autism globally and in the U.S. The CDC reported in 2020 that 1 in 54 children are now diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder, up from 1 in 59 five years ago.
