PROGRAM COST

\$1250.00 for each 3-credit course. Candidates who successfully complete the requirements and receive certification in ESOL will receive a stipend of up to \$300 per credit for a maximum of 15 credits.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Evidence of NYS professional teacher certification in any subject area
- One set of **official** transcripts from **ALL** undergraduate and graduate
- Letter from current employer verifying employment in a NYS school district
- One current letter of recommendation
- Application essay explaining the candidate's interest in working with learners of English as a new language
- Commitment to attending orientation and all in-person class meetings
